That the Joint Commission on Health Care shall enter into a contract with a qualified entity to 9 study options for financing universal health care in the Commonwealth, including (i) a publicly funded single-payer model administered by the Commonwealth for the delivery of health care that is decoupled 10 from employment and (ii) a publicly funded single-payer model administered by private entities pursuant 11 to a contract with the Commonwealth that is decoupled from employment. Such study shall include an 12 13 analysis of financing mechanisms and costs associated with each model and analysis of legal and 14 logistical barriers to implementation of each model, including identification of any waivers that may be necessary to allow use of federal funds available pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1315 and 42 U.S.C. § 18052 15 to finance a model administered by the Commonwealth. The Joint Commission on Health Care shall 16 report the findings, conclusions, and recommendations of the qualified entity to the General Assembly by 17
