6 WHEREAS, Zion Baptist Church, which has long offered sage spiritual leadership, generous
7 outreach, and opportunities for uplifting worship to the residents of Newport News, celebrates its 125th
8 anniversary in 2021; and

9 WHEREAS, in 1896, 13 recent inhabitants of Newport News gathered under a cherry tree in the
10 current location of Zion Baptist Church with the intention of building a religious community; a year
11 later, the church's first building was erected and the congregation called its first pastor, the Reverend
12 Moses Tynes; and

WHEREAS, despite some early setbacks, Zion Baptist Church would continue to grow over the years
 to offer a wide variety of unique ministries and outreach programs designed to support the members of
 the community and enhance the quality of life of all Newport News residents; and

WHEREAS, Zion Baptist Church has been led by the Reverend Dr. Tremayne M. Johnson since
2009, who, with the help of a major architectural renovation and the installation of a new sound and
media system in 2017, has guided the church into an exciting new era; and

19 WHEREAS, members of Zion Baptist Church have become leaders in their professions and the
 20 community, empowered and inspired by the lessons of grace and generosity learned at their home
 21 church; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
 commend Zion Baptist Church for providing edifying spiritual services and outreach ministries that have
 been meeting the needs of the residents of Newport News for the past 125 years; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution
 for presentation to Zion Baptist Church as an expression of the General Assembly's admiration for the
 church's legacy of contributions to the Newport News community.
