10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
	1. That § 20-25 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11 12 13 14	§ 20-25. Persons other than ministers who may perform rites.
13	Upon petition filed with the clerk and payment of applicable clerk's fees, any circuit court judge may
14 1 <i>5</i>	issue an order authorizing one or more persons resident in the circuit in which the judge sits to celebrate
15	the rites of marriage in the Commonwealth. Any person so authorized shall, before acting, enter into
16 17	bond in the penalty of \$500, with or without surety, as the court may direct. Any order made under this
	section may be rescinded at any time. No oath shall be required of a person authorized to celebrate the rites of marriage, nor shall such person be considered an officer of the Commonwealth by virtue of such
18	authorization.
19 20	Any judge or justice of a court of record, any judge of a district court, any retired judge or justice of
20 21	the Commonwealth, and any active, senior, or retired federal judge or justice who is a resident of the

22 23 Commonwealth, and any current member of the General Assembly may celebrate the rites of marriage anywhere in the Commonwealth without the necessity of bond or order of authorization.
