- 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 7 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-474.2 as follows:
 § 18.2-474.2. Bribery in correctional facilities; penalty.

9 A. Any person who receives any pecuniary benefit or other consideration to act in violation of 10 § 18.2-474 or 18.2-474.1 is guilty of bribery, punishable as a Class 4 felony.

11 B. Any law-enforcement officer as defined in § 9.1-101, jail officer as defined in § 53.1-1, or 12 correctional officer as defined in § 53.1-1 who violates this section shall be decertified in accordance 13 with § 15.2-1707, if applicable, and shall be forever ineligible for reemployment as a law-enforcement 14 officer, jail officer, or correctional officer in the Commonwealth.

15 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or

16 commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the 17 necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult

17 necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult 18 correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 1289 of the Acts of Assembly of 2020 requires the

19 Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant

20 to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot

21 be determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
