3. Committee: Passed both Houses.

4. Title: Secretary of Natural Resources.

5. Summary: Renames the Secretary of Natural Resources as the Secretary of Natural and Historic Resources. The bill also designates the Secretary as the Chief Resilience Officer and removes the Virginia Museum of Natural History from the purview of the Secretary.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact. The Secretary of Natural Resources currently serves as the Chief Resilience Officer. Additionally, Executive Order Thirty-One, signed on May 14, 2019, transferred responsibility and oversight of the Virginia Museum of Natural History from the Secretary of Natural Resources to the Secretary of Education.
