5. Summary: Designates the Secretary of Natural Resources as the Chief Resilience Officer and removes the Virginia Museum of Natural History from the purview of the Secretary.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact. The Secretary of Natural Resources currently serves as the Chief Resilience Officer. Additionally, Executive Order Thirty-One, signed on May 14, 2019, transferred responsibility and oversight of the Virginia Museum of Natural History from the Secretary of Natural Resources to the Secretary of Education.
