3. Committee: Passed both houses.

4. Title: Foreign market vehicles; titling.

5. Summary: This bill authorizes the issuance of negotiable titles by the Department of Motor Vehicles for foreign market vehicles that do not meet Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards, as long as the vehicles are 25 years or older. The bill updates the exemption from meeting Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards from vehicles manufactured prior to 1968 to vehicles that are 25 years or older.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles does not anticipate a fiscal impact resulting from this legislation, as minor technical programming changes have already been completed.
