3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Annual safety and disaster awareness training; DHRM, et al., to develop an online training module.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of Human Resource Management, in coordination with the Secretary of Health and Human Resources or his designee, to develop an online training module addressing safety and disaster awareness, which shall be incorporated into existing mandatory training. The bill also requires that all state employees complete the training annually.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No state fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Human Resource Management (DHRM) does not expect a fiscal impact to incorporate the training required by the bill into existing mandatory training.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Human Resource Management, Secretary of Health and Human Resources, and all state agencies.
