3. Committee: Committee on Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Local elections for governing bodies; qualification of voters.

5. Summary: Local elections for governing bodies; elections for school boards; qualification of voters. Provides that in a locality that imposes district-based or ward-based residency requirements for members of the governing body or school board, the member elected from each district or ward is to be elected by the qualified voters of that district or ward and not by the locality at large. The bill has a delayed effective date of January 1, 2022.
