4. **Title:** Department of General Services; removal of Harry F. Byrd, Sr., statue.

5. **Summary:** Directs the Department of General Services to remove the statue of former Virginia Governor and U.S. Senator Harry F. Byrd, Sr., from Capitol Square. The bill directs the department to store the statue until such time as the General Assembly determines its final disposition.

6. **Budget Amendment Necessary:** Yes, Item 79. Conference budget amendment 479#1c provides \$257,000 for the purpose of this bill.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** The Department of General Services (DGS) estimates that it would cost approximately \$250,000 to remove and relocate the statue, and approximately \$7,000 per year to store based on the size of the statue. The bill requires the statue to be stored “until such time as the General Assembly determines and directs the statue's final disposition.” This fiscal impact statement assumes the \$7,000 cost to be ongoing as it is currently unknown when the General Assembly’s determination would be reached.
