2. Patron: Hanger

3. Committee: Passed both Houses.

4. Title: Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board; membership.

5. Summary: Clarifies that each of the six nonlegislative citizen members of the Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board (the Board) who is not an at-large member is to be appointed by the Governor from a list of two qualified nominees submitted for each vacancy by the Board and the Board of Directors of the Virginia Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts in consultation with other groups.

The bill specifies that each of the six nonlegislative citizen members be a resident of a different one of the six geographic areas represented in the Virginia Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts. The bill contains technical amendments.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not result in a fiscal impact to the Department of Conservation and Recreation.
