**4. Title:** Restricted permit; prepayment of fines and costs.

**5. Summary:** This bill provides that any person who is otherwise eligible to receive a restricted permit to operate a motor vehicle shall not be required to pay in full his fines and costs before being issued such restricted permit.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) issues restricted licenses based on court order. Although this bill impacts the circumstances under which Virginia courts may order that a defendant be issued a restricted license, it would not impact DMV's process for issuing restricted licenses based on the terms and conditions of Virginia court orders. No fiscal impact is anticipated for DMV.
