2. Patron: Morrissey

3. Committee: Passed both houses.

4. Title: Restricted permit; prepayment of fines and costs.

5. Summary: This bill provides that any person who is otherwise eligible to receive a restricted permit to operate a motor vehicle shall not be required to pay in full his fines and costs before being issued such restricted permit.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: If an individual's driving privileges are suspended or revoked by a Virginia court, certain provisions of Virginia law permit the individual to petition the court for restricted driving privileges on or after the conviction date. The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) issues restricted licenses based on court order. Although this bill impacts the circumstances under which Virginia courts may order that a defendant be issued a restricted license, it would not impact DMV's process for issuing restricted licenses based on the terms and conditions of Virginia court orders. No fiscal impact is anticipated for DMV.
