- 3. Committee: Education and Health
- 4. Title: Public schools; seizure management and action plans; biennial training.
- **5. Summary:** Provides for the submission and utilization of seizure management and action plans for students with a diagnosed seizure disorder. The bill requires that school nurses and certain school division employees biennially complete Board of Education-approved training in the treatment of students with seizure disorders. The bill provides immunity from civil liability for acts or omissions related to providing for the care of a student under a seizure management and action plan. The substitute version of this bill provides for an effective date of July 1, 2022.
