4. Title: Property; required disclosures for buyer to exercise due diligence.

5. Summary: The substitute bill adds provides that the Real Estate Board shall make available on its website a flood risk information form and prescribes the information that shall be included on such form. The bill also requires that the owner of residential real property located in the Commonwealth who has actual knowledge that the dwelling unit is a repetitive risk loss structure shall disclose such fact to the purchaser. The bill has a delayed effective date of January 1, 2022.
