9 in Richmond's historic Jackson Ward and was founded by Lucy Goode Brooks, a former slave who
10 taught herself to read and write; and

11 WHEREAS, over the years, the FRIENDS Association for Children refocused its mission and now 12 operates two licensed, multiservice child development centers in Gilpin Court and Church Hill; and

WHEREAS, serving children between the ages of six weeks and 17 years, the FRIENDS Association
 for Children strives to build a safe, nurturing, and intellectually stimulating environment for children to
 learn and grow; and

WHEREAS, the FRIENDS Association for Children helps children achieve a better understanding of
 their community, while developing strong foundations for the social and academic skills they need to
 succeed in later schooling; and

19 WHEREAS, in addition to its child development and youth development programs, the FRIENDS
20 Association for Children offers a family development program to support families by providing critical
21 services to families as a unit; and

WHEREAS, the FRIENDS Association for Children has fulfilled its mission through the hard work
 of its dedicated staff members and the generosity and support of volunteers and community partners;
