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VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Chapter 3 of Title 22.1 a section numbered 3 22.1-24.1, relating to Superintendent of Public Instruction; establishment of Internet Safety Advisory 4 Council.

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Approved

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 3 of Title 22.1 a section numbered 9 22.1-24.1 as follows: 10

§ 22.1-24.1. Internet Safety Advisory Council.

11 A. The Superintendent shall establish and appoint members to the Internet Safety Advisory Council 12 (the Council) for the purpose of advancing the goal of safe use of media and technology by students and 13 teachers in public elementary and secondary schools in the Commonwealth.

14 B. The membership of the Council shall include at least one (i) teacher; (ii) librarian; (iii) 15 representative of a parent-teacher organization who is a parent of a school-age child; (iv) school administrator; (v) student; and (vi) individual with expertise in Internet safety and such other individuals 16 17 as the Superintendent deems appropriate, provided that the membership of the Council shall not exceed 18 12. 19

C. The Council shall:

20 1. Develop and recommend to the Board for adoption, after study and consideration of a variety of 21 sources and perspectives, a model policy for local school boards in the Commonwealth that would 22 enable such school boards to better support the Internet safety of all students and teachers in the local 23 school division;

24 2. Develop and recommend to the Board for adoption model instructional practices for the safe use 25 of media and technology by students and teachers in public elementary and secondary schools in the 26 *Commonwealth; and*

27 3. Design and post on the Department's website a page with links to successful instructional 28 practices, curricula, and other teacher resources used in school divisions within and outside of the 29 Commonwealth for the safe use of media and technology by students and teachers.

2. That the provisions of this act shall expire on July 1, 2024. 30

3. That the Internet Safety Advisory Council established by this act shall submit a report of its 31 findings to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on 32 33 Education and Health no later than October 31, 2023.

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
