13	feasibility and benefits of transferring responsibility for the Department of Juvenile Justice from the
14	Secretary of Public Safety and Homeland Security to the Secretary of Health and Human Resources. The
15	work group shall be composed of interested parties, including representatives from civil liberty
16	organizations, organizations engaged in the daily work of youth justice and violence prevention,
17	formerly incarcerated persons and their families, and mental health experts. The work group shall
18	submit its report containing the work group's findings by November 1, 2022, to the Chairmen of the

19 House Committee for Courts of Justice, House Committee on Public Safety, Senate Committee on the Judiciary, and Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services.
