That in any proceeding pursuant to subsection C of § 56-585.5 of the Code of Virginia, each Phase 1 Utility or Phase 2 Utility, as such terms are defined in subdivision A 1 of § 56-585.1 of the 9 10 Code of Virginia, shall prioritize procurement of renewable energy certificates (RECs) from renewable energy standard sources (RPS eligible sources) located in the Commonwealth. Additionally, to promote 12 13 economic development in the counties and cities eligible for funding through the Tobacco [Commission Region Revitalization Commission, each utility shall include in its annual filing a plan for prioritizing 14 procurement of RECs from RPS eligible sources that are eligible for the Virginia Brownfield and Coal 15 Mine Renewable Energy [Grand Grant] Fund and Program established pursuant to § 45.2-1725 of the 16 17 Code of Virginia.

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
