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9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 32.1-137.01 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 32.1-137.01. Posting of charity care policies.
12	All hospitals A. Every hospital shall provide written information about the hospital's charity care
13	policies, including policies related to free and discounted care. Such information shall be posted
14	conspicuously in public areas of the hospital, including admissions or registration areas, emergency
15	departments, and associated waiting rooms. Information regarding specific eligibility criteria and
16 17	procedures for applying for charity care shall <i>also</i> be (i) provided to a patient at the time of admission or discharge, or at the time services are provided _{7} ; (ii) included with any billing statements sent to
18	uninsured patients; and (iii) included on any website maintained by the hospital.
19	B. Every hospital that is subject to the requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as
20	amended, shall make available information about the hospital's charity care policies, including
21	information regarding specific eligibility criteria and procedures for applying for charity care, to
$\overline{22}$	individuals with low English proficiency in the same manner and languages, and to the same degree, as
23	the hospital makes available other information regarding hospital programs and services. Such
24	information shall be (i) provided to a patient at the time of admission or discharge, or at the time
