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9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 53.1-40.01 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11 12	<b>§ 53.1-40.01. Conditional release of geriatric prisoners.</b> Any person serving a sentence imposed upon a conviction for a felony offense, other than:
13	a 1. A Class 1 felony; or
14	2. One of the following offenses, provided that such offense was committed on or after July 1, 2022:
15	a. Any violation of § 18.2-32, 18.2-32.1, 18.2-32.2, or 18.2-33;
16	b. Any violation of § 18.2-40 or 18.2-45;
17 18	c. Any violation of § 18.2-46.5, subsection A or B of § 18.2-46.6, or § 18.2-46.7; d. Any kidnapping or abduction felony under Article 3 (§ 18.2-47 et seq.) of Chapter 4 of Title 18.2,

55	Board shall promulgate regulations to implement the provisions of this section.
