10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 32.1-137.05 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 32.1-137.05. Information regarding standard charges; advance estimate of patient payment
13	amount for elective procedure, test, or service.
14	A. Every hospital shall make available to the public on its website (i) a machine-readable file
15	containing a list of all standard charges for all items and services provided by the hospital and (ii) a
16	list of standard charges for the 300 most frequently provided services and items, which shall include as
17	many of the 70 services required by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to be made
18	available to the public as the hospital offers and which shall be made available in plain language and
19	in a format that easily accessible by the public.
20	B. Every hospital shall, upon request of a patient scheduled to receive an elective procedure, test, or
21	service to be performed by the hospital, or upon request of such patient's legally authorized
22	representative, made no less than three days in advance of the date on which such elective procedure,
23	test, or service is scheduled to be performed, furnish the patient with an estimate of the payment amount
24	for which the participant will be responsible for such elective procedure, test, or service. Every hospital
25	shall provide written information about the patient's ability to request an estimate of the payment amount

27 28 pursuant to this section. Such written information shall be posted conspicuously in public areas of the hospital, including admissions or registration areas, and included on any website maintained by the

hospital.
