9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That §§ 2.2-2545 and 2.2-2547 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 2.2-2545. (Expires July 1, 2027) Membership; terms.
12	A. The Commission shall have a total membership of 22 26 members that shall consist of four
13	legislative members, 17 nonlegislative citizen members, and five ex officio members. Members shall be
14	appointed as follows:
15	1. [ <i>Two members</i> One member] of the Senate, to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules;
16	2. [ <del>Two</del> Three ] members of the House of Delegates, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
17	Delegates in accordance with the principles of proportional representation contained in the Rules of the
18	House of Delegates;
19	3. One representative from each of the lead commemoration partners: the Jamestown-Yorktown
20	Foundation, the primary state agency and fiscal agent; the Virginia Museum of History & Culture, the
21	primary nonstate agency; and Gunston Hall, the primary representative of Virginia's historic homes and
22	related sites;
$\overline{23}$	2. 4. One representative from the American Battlefield Trust, the secretariat of the United States
24	Semiquincentennial Commission, and one representative from the Virginia Bar Association;
25	$\frac{3}{5}$ Six members appointed by the Governor from a list of 10 provided by the
26	Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation; and
27	4. 6. Six members appointed by the Governor from a list of 10 provided by the Virginia Museum of
28	History & Culture.
<b>2</b> 9	The Secretary of Education, the Librarian of Virginia, the Director of the Department of Historic
30	Resources, the Executive Director of Virginia Humanities, and the Chief Executive Officer of the
31	Virginia Tourism Authority, or their designees, shall serve as ex officio members with voting privileges.
32	Nonlegislative citizen members of the Commission shall be citizens of the Commonwealth.
33	B. The Commission shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership.
33 34	C. Legislative members of the Commission shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office.
35	Nonlegislative citizen members shall be appointed for the duration of the Commission's activities.
35 36	Appointments to fill vacancies shall be for the unexpired terms. Vacancies shall be filled in the same
