1	cancer characterized by very low survival rates; it accounts for one to five percent of all diagnosed
12	breast cancers; and
13	WHEREAS, inflammatory breast cancer often does not form a lump that can be detected in a
14	self-exam or mammogram; it is frequently initially mistaken for an infection; and
15	WHEREAS, due to its rapid spread through the body, inflammatory breast cancer has often already
16	reached an advanced stage by the time it is detected, making it difficult to successfully treat; and
17	WHEREAS, more research into inflammatory breast cancer is needed in order to understand risk
18	factors, advance methods for early detection and treatment, and improve the prognosis for patients with
19	inflammatory breast cancer; and
20	WHEREAS, to stay healthy, Virginians must know the signs and symptoms, understand treatment
21	options, and recognize the need for increased research into inflammatory breast cancer; now, therefore,
