6 WHEREAS, Paul Marik, M.D., a licensed physician in the Commonwealth specializing in the field 7 of critical care medicine, has served as a bedside physician caring for gravely ill patients for more than 8 35 years; and

9 WHEREAS, Paul Marik is board-certified in both internal medicine and critical care medicine by the 10 American Board of Internal Medicine and is a fellow of the American College of Physicians, the American College of Chest Physicians, and the Society of Critical Care Medicine; and 11

WHEREAS, Paul Marik has received numerous teaching awards, including the national Award for 12 13 Outstanding Educator of Residents and Fellows from the American College of Physicians in 2017; and

14 WHEREAS, over his esteemed career, Paul Marik has authored or co-authored four books, 80 book 15 chapters, and more than 520 peer-reviewed journal articles on diverse topics relevant to the critical care 16 setting; and

WHEREAS, in the face of the COVID-19 pandemic, Paul Marik was profoundly affected by the 17 plight and suffering of many intensive care unit patients and pursued treatments using alternative 18 19 therapeutic medicines and supplements; and

WHEREAS, Paul Marik co-founded the nonprofit organization Front Line COVID-19 Critical Care 20 21 Alliance (FLCCC) with other clinical experts whose sole mission was to develop and share the most effective COVID-19 treatment protocols; and 22

23 WHEREAS, Paul Marik and the FLCCC devised the MATH+ Protocol, which has been used and 24 adopted by many clinicians and hospitals worldwide to lower rates of mechanical ventilation and save 25 lives: and

26 WHEREAS, Paul Marik has published 15 peer-reviewed publications on COVID-19 and has lectured 27 at multiple national and international conferences, bravely presenting his knowledge of COVID-19 28 treatments and the MATH+ Protocol to thousands of physicians worldwide in the face of massive 29 institutional opposition; and

30 WHEREAS, one of the most experienced physicians in treating critically ill COVID-19 patients, Paul 31 Marik has provided guidance to other expert physicians across the globe to help them treat their own 32 COVID-19 patients; now, therefore, be it 33
