6 WHEREAS, Big H.O.M.I.E.S., a nonprofit community outreach program dedicated to reducing gun
7 violence in Portsmouth and Hampton Roads, has greatly served the community through various
8 initiatives; and

9 WHEREAS, Big H.O.M.I.E.S., which stands for "Heroes of Minority in Every Society," was founded
10 in 2019 in response to the alarming prevalence of gun violence in the Portsmouth and Hampton Roads
11 communities; and

WHEREAS, Big H.O.M.I.E.S. administers programs, extracurricular and sports activities, a safe
 house, and other community services to break down barriers, build positive relationships, and steer
 young people away from a life of crime; and

15 WHÊRÊAS, in August 2021, Big H.O.M.I.E.S. partnered with the City of Portsmouth for a
16 back-to-school event at Portsmouth City Park that brought local organizations and businesses together to
17 help young people start the school year off on the right foot; and

18 WHEREAS, Big H.O.M.I.E.S. has organized events at Norfolk State University football games to
 19 offer young people from different neighborhoods the opportunity to cultivate new perspectives and
 20 friendships; and

WHEREAS, Big H.O.M.I.E.S. recently launched its Portsmouth Safe Streets Initiative to provide
 mentoring, job training, mediation, group therapy, sports training, counseling, tutoring, mental health and
 substance abuse referrals, and other services for the benefit of many individuals and families; and

WHEREAS, by serving as a reliable source of motivation and support to area youth, Big H.O.M.I.E.S. has helped address the issue of gun violence in the community and enabled countless young people in Portsmouth and Hampton Roads to lead safer and more fulfilling lives; now, therefore, be it
