10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 19.2-77 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 19.2-77. Escape, flight and pursuit; arrest anywhere in Commonwealth.
13	Whenever a person in the custody of an officer shall escape or whenever a person shall flee from an
14	officer attempting to arrest him, such officer, with or without a warrant, may pursue such person
15	anywhere in the Commonwealth and, when actually in close pursuit, may arrest him wherever he is
16	found. If the arrest is made in a county or city adjoining that from which the accused fled, or in any
17	area of the Commonwealth within one mile of the boundary of the county or city from which he fled,
18	the officer may forthwith return the accused before the proper official of the county or city from which
19	he fled. If the arrest is made beyond the foregoing limits, the officer shall proceed according to the
20	provisions of § 19.2-76, and if such arrest is made without a warrant, the officer shall procure a warrant
21	from the magistrate serving the county or city wherein the arrest was made, charging the accused with
22	the offense committed, and any criminal act committed during the close pursuit, in the county or city
23	from which he fled.
