10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 46.2-821 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-821. Vehicles before entering certain highways shall stop or yield right-of-way.
13	The driver of a vehicle approaching an intersection on a highway controlled by a stop sign shall,
14	immediately before entering such intersection, stop at a clearly marked stop line, or, in the absence of a
15	stop line, stop before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, or, in the absence of a
16	marked crosswalk, stop at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of
17	approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway. Before proceeding, he shall yield the right-of-way to the
18	driver of any vehicle approaching on such other highway from either direction. If the operator of a
19	bicycle fails to stop as required by this section, the operator shall be subject, in addition to any other
20	fines or penalties set forth in this title, to a minimum fine of \$500, and the law-enforcement officer
21	issuing the citation shall impound the operator's bicycle for a period of six months.
22	Where a "Yield Right-of-Way" sign is posted, the driver of a vehicle approaching or entering such
23	intersection shall slow down to a speed reasonable for the existing conditions, yield the right-of-way to
24	the driver of another vehicle approaching or entering such intersection from another direction and if

the driver of another vehicle approaching or entering such intersection from another direction, and, if required for safety, shall stop at a clearly marked stop or yield line, or, in the absence of a stop or yield line, stop before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway, and shall yield the right-of-way to the driver of any vehicle approaching on such other highway from either direction. 25 26 27 28
