6	A BILL to require the Department of Medical Assistance Services to continue the work group to study
7	options for the permanent use of virtual supports and increasing access to virtual supports and
8	services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. The Department of Medical Assistance Services shall continue the work group composed of
11	individuals with developmental disabilities, families of individuals with developmental disabilities,
12	representatives of advocacy organizations, and other appropriate stakeholders to study and develop
13	recommendations for the permanent use of virtual supports and increasing access to virtual supports
14	and services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities by promoting access to
15	assistive technology and environmental modifications. The Department shall report its findings and
16	recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly by November 1, 2022.
