11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-1219.3 as follows:
12	§ 46.2-1219.3. Parking of vehicles in parking spaces reserved for charging electric vehicles; civil
13	penalties.
14	A. It shall constitute a traffic infraction for any person to park a vehicle that is not a plug-in electric
15	motor vehicle, as defined in § 56-1, in a parking space clearly marked as reserved for charging plug-in
16	electric motor vehicles. A violation of this subsection is subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$100
17	nor more than \$250.
18	B. Any vehicle that is not a plug-in electric motor vehicle and is parked in such a spot shall also be
19	subject to towing and impoundment as a trespassing vehicle pursuant to this article or any local
20	ordinance adopted pursuant to the same, provided that the general parking area contains necessary
21	signage to authorize towing.
22	C. The governing body of any county, city, or town may adopt an ordinance not inconsistent with the
23	provisions of this section. The civil penalty for violating any such ordinance shall not exceed the civil
24	penalties provided in subsection A.
25	D. In the prosecution of an offense established under this section, prima facie evidence that the
26	vehicle described in the summons issued pursuant to this section was parked in violation of this section,

together with proof that the defendant was at the time of such violation the owner, lessee, or renter of
the vehicle, shall constitute in evidence a rebuttable presumption that such owner, lessee, or renter of
