12	§ 44-146.29:3. Emergency Shelters Upgrade Assistance Grant Fund.
13	There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the
	Emergency Shelters Upgrade Assistance Grant Fund, referred to in this section as "the Fund." The Fund
	hall be established on the books of the Comptroller. All funds appropriated for such purpose and any
	ifts, donations, grants, bequests, and other funds received on its behalf shall be paid into the state
	easury and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and
	e credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal
	ear shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used
	olely for the purposes of providing matching funds to localities or entities previously outlined in a local
	<i>helter plan</i> to install, maintain, or repair infrastructure for backup energy generation for emergency
22 sł	helters, including solar energy generators, and improve the hazard-specific structural integrity of shelter acilities owned by the locality or <i>identified in the shelter plan of the locality</i> . Expenditures and

facilities owned by the locality or identified in the shelter plan of the locality.
