16	A. The Department shall develop or obtain a mental health mobile application for suicide prevention
17	and the provision of educational materials related to suicide prevention. The mobile application shall
18	provide a means to directly connect to the 988 Suicide Prevention Lifeline.
19	B. The Secretary of Health and Human Resources and the Secretary of Education shall determine
20	and direct the appropriate agencies to promote, market, and advertise the use of the mental health
21	mobile application throughout the Commonwealth through such agencies' existing staff and digital
22 23	programs.
23	§ 52-49.1. Public safety mobile application.
24	A. The Department of State Police, in coordination with the Virginia Fusion Intelligence Center (the
25 26	Center), shall develop or obtain a public safety mobile application to provide to individuals in the
20 27	Commonwealth a platform that is capable of receiving text, audio, images, and video to submit confidential tips concerning (i) a suspected, anticipated, or completed criminal violation or (ii) bullying,
28	threats of school violence, or other school-related safety concerns. The public safety mobile application

3 0	coordination with the Center, shall develop a referral system to ensure that confidential tips received
31	through the mobile application are referred to the appropriate law-enforcement agency, school board,
