Grantor is authorized to convey to Grantee easements for the purposes of: (i) providing 15 non-vehicular access to and from the green space to be installed by Grantor on the Grantor Property 16

and allowing recreational use of such green space; (ii) providing vehicular and pedestrian access over the paved driveways on the Grantor Property for access to and from the parking deck constructed by Grantor on the Grantor Property; and (iii) allowing Grantee to park motor vehicles, except for buses, within such parking deck.

§ 3. That the easements shall be granted and conveyed upon such terms that Grantor deems proper, with the approval of the Department of General Services and the Secretary of Administration and in a

Grantor is hereby authorized to prepare, execute, and deliver such deed, easement, and other documents as may be necessary or appropriate to accomplish the conveyance.
