11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-208.03 as follows:
13	§ 22.1-208.03. Curricula and instruction including inherently divisive concepts prohibited.
14	A. As used in this section, "inherently divisive concepts" means advancing any ideas in violation of
15	Title IV and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, including the following concepts: (i)
16	one race, sex, or faith is inherently superior to another race, sex, or faith; (ii) an individual, by virtue
17	of his or her race, sex, or faith, is inherently racist, sexist, or oppressive, whether consciously or
18	subconsciously; (iii) an individual should be discriminated against or receive adverse treatment solely or
19	partly because of his or her race, sex, or faith; (iv) members of one race, sex, or faith cannot and
20	should not attempt to treat others as individuals without respect to race, sex, or faith; (v) an individual's
21	moral character is inherently determined by his or her race, sex, or faith; (vi) an individual, by virtue of
22	
23	his or her race, sex, or faith, bears responsibility for actions committed in the past by other members of
	his or her race, sex, or faith, bears responsibility for actions committed in the past by other members of the same race, sex, or faith; and (vii) meritocracy or traits, such as a hard work ethic, are racist or

25 B. Each public elementary or secondary school principal shall ensure that no curriculum utilized or
26 instruction delivered in the school includes inherently divisive concepts, regardless of whether such
27 curriculum or instruction is provided by a school board employee or any other individual or entity.
