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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 2.2-3904 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 2.2-3904. Nondiscrimination in places of public accommodation; definitions.
14	A. As used in this section:
15	"Age" means being an individual who is at least 18 years of age.
16	"Place of public accommodation" means all places or businesses offering or holding out to the
17	general public goods, services, privileges, facilities, advantages, or accommodations.
18	B. It is an unlawful discriminatory practice for any person, including the owner, lessee, proprietor,
19	manager, superintendent, agent, or employee of any place of public accommodation, to refuse, withhold
20	from, or deny any individual, or to attempt to refuse, withhold from, or deny any individual, directly or
21	indirectly, any of the accommodations, advantages, facilities, services, or privileges made available in
22	any place of public accommodation, or to segregate or discriminate against any such person in the use
23	thereof, or to publish, circulate, issue, display, post, or mail, either directly or indirectly, any
24	communication, notice, or advertisement to the effect that any of the accommodations, advantages,
25	facilities, privileges, or services of any such place shall be refused, withheld from, or denied to any
26	individual on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, pregnancy, childbirth or related
27	medical conditions, age, sexual orientation, gender identity, marital status, disability, or military status.
28	C. It is an unlawful discriminatory practice for any person, including the owner, lessee, proprietor,
29	manager, superintendent, agent, or employee of any place of public accommodation, to refuse, withhold
30	from, or deny any individual, or to attempt to refuse, withhold from, or deny any individual, directly or
31	indirectly, any of the accommodations, advantages, facilities, services, or privileges made available in
32	any place of public accommodation, or to segregate or discriminate against any such person in the use
33	thereof, or to publish, circulate, issue, display, post, or mail, either directly or indirectly, any
34	communication, notice, or advertisement to the effect that any of the accommodations, advantages,
35	facilities, privileges, or services of any such place shall be refused, withheld from, or denied to any
36	individual because the individual is or is not wearing a face covering for the purpose of preventing the
37	transmission of COVID-19. For the purposes of this subdivision, "place of public accommodation"
38	includes any public or private elementary or secondary school and any public or private institution of
39	higher education.
40	D. The provisions of this section subsection B shall not apply to a private club, a place of
41	accommodation owned by or operated on behalf of a religious corporation, association, or society that is
42	not in fact open to the public, or any other establishment that is not in fact open to the public.
43	D. E. The provisions of this section shall not prohibit (i) discrimination against individuals who are
