10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 58.1-3252 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
<b>12</b>	§ 58.1-3252. In counties.
13	There shall be a general reassessment of real estate every four years or, if determined by majority
14	vote of a county's board of supervisors, every three years. Any county that, however, has a total
15	population of 50,000 or less may elect by majority vote of its board of supervisors to conduct its
16	general reassessments at either five-year or six-year intervals. In addition, Augusta County and Bedford
<b>17</b>	County may elect by majority vote of their respective board of supervisors to conduct their general
18	reassessments at either five-year or six-year intervals.

Nothing in this section shall affect the power of any county to use the annual or biennial assessment method as authorized by law.
