13	A. As used in this section, "gaming business" means any person who holds or has applied for a
14	permit or license under the provisions of Article 2 (§ 58.1-4030 et seq.) or Chapter 41 (§ 58.1-4100 et
15	seq.), or any affiliate thereof.
16	B. A gaming business is prohibited from using the name of Virginia or the Commonwealth in an
17	advertisement in association with its product or service. Any gaming business that violates the provision
18	of this section shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than \$50,000. The Director shall enforce
19 20	the provisions of this section. C. All civil panelties collected pursuant to this section shall account to the general fund.
