4. Title: Notice and sale prior to discontinuing natural gas utility service; public entities.

5. Summary: Prior to generally discontinuing natural gas utility service to any commercial or industrial customers, public entities shall provide at least three years' notice and attempt to negotiate the sale of its system facilities to ensure continued service for one year. Failing a successful sale of the system facilities and associated rights, the system assets will be offered for auction.

Copies of all publications of notice related to discontinuing service and the sale of system facilities shall be provided to the State Corporation Commission at the time they are made.
