8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> As stand-alone legislation, the Department of Elections considers implementation of this bill as "routine," and does not require additional funding.						
	The bill provides for civil penalties not to exceed \$25,000 for disclosure violations that expressly advocate the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate, which shall be deposited in the general fund. Any potential revenue impact from the assessment of civil penalties is indeterminate.
