4. Title: Electric utilities; removal of waste coal from previously mined sites.

5. Summary: Provides that in furtherance of both the need to maintain a reliable and adequate supply of electricity and to address the environmental hazards of abandoned coal mines the removal of waste coal from previously mined sites in the coalfield region of the Commonwealth for the purpose of using such waste coal as fuel for the generation of electricity is in the public interest. The bill authorizes a Phase I or Phase II Utility to petition the State Corporation Commission for approval of a rate adjustment clause for recovery of the costs of such removal.
