4.	Title:	Emergency custody and temporary detention; transportation					transportation and custody.

- 5. Summary: Amends several sections of the Code related to emergency custody and temporary detention of minors and adults. It provides that the provision of emergency medical treatment or evaluation may not toll the running of the time period of emergency custody. It also provides that emergency custody orders may not be extended, successive emergency custody orders may not be entered, and the subject of the order shall be released if no temporary detention order is issued. Additionally, magistrates may not issue temporary detention orders if there is no facility ready and able to accept the subject of the order. It also requires state facilities to take custody of such individuals immediately upon completion of transportation and arrival of the person at the facility; if the facility fails to do so, the temporary detention order is voided.

- **8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of State Police (VSP), there is no anticipated fiscal impact on agency operations as a result of the provisions of the proposed legislation.
