3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: School Health Advisory Board; established, report.

5. Summary: Establishes the School Health Advisory Board in the executive branch to advise the General Assembly and the Governor on pending or proposed legislation concerning the role of employees in public elementary or secondary schools in providing health care services at such schools and provide guidance on any associated training requirements.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: Yes, Item 135.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary, see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Education (DOE), it does not have available staff to fulfill this requirement. DOE estimates it will require \$15,000 per year in wage support to staff the advisory board and an additional \$10,000 per year to reimburse board members for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. There is no impact to the Department of Health. The total state fiscal impact of this bill is \$25,000 annually.
