3. Committee: Public Safety

4. Title: Arrest and summons quotas; prohibition.

5. Summary: Provides that no agency of the Commonwealth employing law enforcement officers, including sheriffs, any police force, and the Department of State Police, shall establish a formal or informal quota that requires officers to make a specific number of arrests or to issue a specific number of summonses in a designated time period. Additionally, the bill prohibits using the number of arrests made or summonses issued by a law enforcement officer as the sole criterion for evaluating the officer's job performance.

8. Fiscal Implications: There is no anticipated fiscal impact on the Department of State Police (VSP) as a result of the provisions of this bill. Any potential fiscal impact on local law enforcement agencies is indeterminate at this time.
