- **2. Patron:** Kiggans
- 3. Committee: Privileges and Elections
- **4. Title:** Voter registration; list maintenance; lists of decedents transmitted by State Registrar.
- **5. Summary:** Requires the State Registrar of Vital Records to transmit to the Department of Elections a weekly list of decedents from the previous week. Currently, this list is transmitted monthly. The bill requires the general registrars to promptly cancel the registration of a person known to be deceased or otherwise disqualified to vote.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: See Item 8.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: As stand-alone legislation, the Department of Elections considers implementation of this bill as "routine," and does not require additional funding. This bill is also not expected to have a fiscal impact on the Virginia Department of Health.
- **9.** Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Elections, State Board of Elections, Virginia Department of Health, and localities (General Registrars and Electoral Boards).
