8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of this legislation would have a fiscal impact on the Virginia Department of Health (VDH). The bill requires that VDH shall provide staff support to the Council. VDH has stated this cannot be absorbed within existing resources. VDH's Office of Family Health Services would need a contractor, estimated at \$40,976 annually, to provide staff support. This is based on 1,040 hours per fiscal year at a bill rate of \$37.75 per hour for a total of \$39,260. VITA costs are \$1,470 and phone costs are \$246. The total fiscal impact will be \$40,976. The contractor will support the Council with coordination, communications, setting up meetings and planning calls, attending meetings and planning calls, taking notes, and interfacing with VDH Shared Business Services regarding Renal Disease Fund requests.
