5.	<b>Summary:</b> This bill directs the Department of Motor Vehicles to establish a method by which an applicant for a driver's license or identification card may indicate his blood type to be noted on his license or card for the purpose of providing emergency medical support by emergency medical services agencies. The bill prohibits the disclosure of such data and provides that the Department is not liable for the accuracy of such data. The bill has a delayed effective date of July 1, 2023.

8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> This bill would require the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to offer a process in which applicants for original, reissued, or renewed driver's licenses or identification cards may choose to indicate their blood type. If a blood type is provided, DMV would then print it on the credential and add the information to the customer's record. The agency would not be required to verify the blood type designation of the customers.
