5. Summary: Includes in the definition of “critically missing adult” an adult who has a developmental disability, intellectual disability, or mental illness, and anyone 18 years of age or older whose disappearance indicates a credible threat to their health and safety.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8 below.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of State Police (VSP) oversees the Virginia Critically Missing Adult Alert Program. VSP does not anticipate any fiscal impact on agency operations as a result of the provisions of this bill. Any potential fiscal impact on local law enforcement agencies is indeterminate at this time.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of State Police and local law enforcement agencies.
