3. Committee: Judiciary

4. Title: Criminal history record information check required to sell firearm; exception, concealed permit.

5. Summary: Provides that a person may sell a firearm to another person in a private sale that is not subject to a criminal history record check if the purchaser has a valid concealed handgun permit and produces the permit to the seller at the time of the sale, and the purchaser is not prohibited under state or federal law from possessing a firearm.
