**4. Title:** Virginia Board of Workforce Development; powers and duties; collaboration.

**5. Summary:** Directs the Virginia Board of Workforce Development to prepare recommendations for creating a primary office for apprenticeship programs.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that the Virginia Board of Workforce Development (the Board) can carry out the requirements of this bill with existing resources.
