4. Title: Virginia Residential Landlord and Tenant Act; prohibited provisions in rental agreements.

5. Summary: The substituted bill provides that a rental agreement may contain provisions that allow the operation of child care services provided by a tenant of an apartment building that meet state and local laws and regulations and that are provided solely to other residents of the apartment building.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Housing and Community Development has no oversight or administrative obligations regarding the Virginia Residential Landlord and Tenant Act.
